

Wetenskapblok vorder fluks en vergelyk met dié van die beste

"Die mikpunt is om kleur en 'n moderne konteks te laai inval by die bestaande historiese geboue van Grey," is die woorde van Henri Pretorius, argitek van die nuwe wetenskaplaboratoriums.

Hierdie nuwe laboratoriums sal op die grasperk langs die H-blok gebou word. Planne is ook opgetrek om die huidige asbesgeboue te vervang met vier behoorlik-gestruktureerde klaskamers. Volgens mnr Pretorius word daar respek betoon aan die historiese geboue deur die nuwe laboratoriums op 'n moderne manier te bou en nie die vorm van die bestaande strukture na te boots nie. "Oud en nuut moet mekaar komplementeer," sê hy.

Mnr Lourens van der Merwe, departementshoof Fisiiese Wetenskappe sê: "Die nuwe laboratoriums sal meer leerders kan akkommodeer en beter toerusting sal beskikbaar wees om praktiese lesse aan te bied."

"Ek is baie tevrede met die ontwikkelinge tot dusver," sê mnr Deon Scheepers.

Projekbestuurder mnr Lodewyk Pretorius sê die totale koste van die nuwe laboratoriums word beraam op ongeveer R8.5 miljoen, BTW uitgesluit. Die projek word gefinansier deur onder ander die Jock Meiring Trust (R2.6 miljoen), skenkings van oud-Greys en opgehoede reserves oordie jare.

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Is hatred an excuse to commit violence?

A multicultural school like Grey College is particularly susceptible to the devastating effects of xenophobic attitudes. These can be seen whenever fights erupt due to discrimination or intolerance of a specific race or culture.

On the school grounds, no one dares call these incidents of xenophobic attacks, but they are the seeds of xenophobia? Do they germinate in our own classrooms, whenever we negate the value that other cultures and racial groups bring to our community?

In 2015, another nationwide spike in xenophobic attacks against immigrants in general prompted a number of foreign governments to begin repatriating their citizens.


In April 2015, xenophobic attacks started in Durban and spread to Johannesburg. This included shops being looted and foreign nationals attacked.

Xenophobia is defined as an unreasonable fear or hatred of foreigners or strangers. Before 1994, when South Africa was still under the apartheid regime, discrimination and violence against immigrants were common and generally attributed to the institutionalised racism of the time.

The power to conquer xenophobia lies in our ability to conquer discrimination. As Thomas Jefferson said: "We hold these truths to be self-evident: that all men are created equal; that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights; that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness".

Learners show disturbingly little interest in and knowledge of world affairs

Is the current era making us ignorant? Every day we are inundated with popcorn for the soul, fleeting and superficial information that means nothing. We are more concerned about what's trending, who is dating whom and who posted what, as opposed to who the new leader of the DA is and what is happening in Nepal.

Listening to the news allows you to develop your intelligence and gives you a greater general knowledge. It also gives you a wider viewpoint on the world and allows

you to become a better conversationalist; it heightens your awareness of important issues and it can make you thankful for what you have.

A questionnaire was distributed to see how much the average learner knows about what is going on in the world around us and it also reflected how the reading and watching of news improves general knowledge. The questionnaire consisted of 8 questions and was handed out to 36 Grey College learners in grade 11 and 12.

The questionnaire asked that the candidate indicate whether or

not they watched the news and whether or not they read the newspaper. This isolated 4 groups, namely learners who don't watch or read news [None]; learners who only watch the news on television [TV]; learners who read the newspaper [Newspaper] and learners who read and watch the news [Both].

A graph was created indicating the number of learners per group and it showed that reading and watching news improves general knowledge. It is clear that the majority of learners don't watch or read news. As can be seen on the graph, the smaller percentage,

which are the learners who watch and read news had a higher percentage of questions correct compared to the rest of the groups. These graphs clearly show that the majority of learners are ignorant to what is happening in the world around us.

It also shows that learners are more concerned with what is happening on a social level than with the cause and effect of the decisions made by leaders, or with issues such as natural disasters.

As potential leaders of the country, learners should be aware of global issues.

MySchool Dream School gives hope for tomorrow

The hit television series MySchool Dream School showed South African viewers how 15 so-called school "drop-outs" were given a second chance at achieving their full academic potential.

These learners all gather in Cape Town each year for a specific period of time, where they are educated in very small groups. They do not follow the traditional school curriculum, but work hard to

discover their self-worth and a sense of empowerment to try and become grounded members of society.

One of these learners is Nisa, a grade 11 learner whose education comes second to staying alive. Another one is Wautina, who left school in grade 9 as a result of a motorbike accident and suffered severe depression before leaving and Tshepo, who struggled to cope after the loss of both his parents.

They and 12 other learners were all given a second chance at

Dream School.

Their activities are followed by a television team and the show is co-hosted by Anele Mdoda, formerly of 5FM, together with Johan Volsteedt, previous headmaster of Grey College. "Being able to touch the lives of young South Africans in such a manner is beyond rewarding," says Mr Volsteedt.

The teaching staff include Judge Dennis Goldberg, author and journalist Tim Butcher, Prof Jonathan Jansen of the UFS, the Cobras coach Paul Adams, Freshly Ground singer Zolani Mahola, celebrity cook Karen Dudley and Dance for All's Phillip Boyd.

Mr Volsteedt said that throughout his years at Grey he has learnt so much about teenagers, their aspirations and their fears and he believes that what these society drop-outs crave most of all is a little attention and support.

All 15 of these learners received a study bursary from Abbotts College to complete their schooling. Mr Volsteedt still remains in contact with many of the pupils who attended the first Dream School and he says that for the most part, they are doing very well.

The Dream School crew has just completed another 26 episodes which will be aired shortly on South African television.

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

played the violin.



From this it can easily be seen that rugby was not even considered in the founding years of the school



The band's original members were the two brothers Malcolm and

Angus Young until Malcolm left the band in 2014 due to illness. The band's line-up changed often from 1973 up until 1995: bassist Cliff Williams replaced Mark Evans in 1977.

Bon Scott died on 19 February 1980 after a night of drinking and Brian Johnson, ex-Geordie singer, became the new vocalist. The band released a new album later that year, *Back in Black*, as a tribute to Bon Scott.

In 1983 drummer Phil Rudd was fired and replaced by Simon Wright, but returned in 1995, after Chris Slade, who was with the band

for 6 years, was asked to leave in favour of him.

The band has released 17 albums since the release of their first album, *High Voltage*, in 1975. In 2014 they released *Rock or Bust* which was the first album in the band's history without Malcolm Young on the recordings.

AC/DC has been nominated seven times at the annual Grammy Awards but only succeeded to win the award for the Best Hard Rock Performance in 2010. AC/DC were inducted into the highly acclaimed Rock-and-Roll Hall of Fame in 2003 and during the ceremony the band performed *Highway to Hell* and *You Shook Me All Night Long*.

AC/DC is the fifth best-selling band in US history and the tenth best-selling artist, selling more albums than Madonna and Mariah Carey.

This group of 60-year-old rock-and-rollers is currently busy with their *Rock or Bust World Tour* in support of their album. They show no sign of quitting or slowing down and are continuing their reign as kings of rock-and-roll.




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
