## Pierre Korkie's fate is still undecided

"Pierre Korkie was always smiling," according to mrs Hancke, a teacher at Grey College High School. After 23 years of dedication to Grey College as Biology teacher, mr Korkie decided to follow his vision to spread the word of God. He and his wife Yolande Korkie together with their two children then moved to Yemen where mr Korkie was appointed as a teacher and Mrs Korkie was a relief worker. They spent four years in Yemen before being captured by Al-Qaeda in May 2013. The children returned safely to South Africa.

After what seemed to be a millennium mrs Yolande Korkie was released and returned to South Africa on 13 January 2014, after intense negotiations between his employers, Gift of The Givers and Al-Qaeda.


Al-Qaeda set a deadline of 17 January 2014 for the payment of a ransom of R 32,5 million for the safe return of Pierre Korkie. Al-Qaeda also threatened the Korkie family that if they did not pay the ransom he would be executed immediately.

Despite South Africa's policy of non-negotiation with terrorists, many people donated money to the cause, urged to do so on many social media platforms. Al-Qaeda then extended the deadline by three weeks and mrs Korkie made a televised plea for mercy, without any noteworthy response. Mr Korkie suffers from a hernia and is not capable of surviving in captivity, she said. He is also said to be totally deaf by now.

Communications between Al-Qaeda were interrupted on 26 January 2014, and nothing definite has been heard since then. "We should all pray for his safe return," said mrs. Hancke.

Mrs Korkie recently visited the school and prayed for the protection and release of her husband and all people in similar situations. She obviously is unable to comment on the progress or not of any negotiations with the kidnappers. The worst of the situation is when the kidnappers retreat into silence, as the lack of news is harrowing. However the whole of South Africa awaits the release of mr Korkie.

### Thieves continue to target learners and parents at Grey

Theft is a crime, but yet so many people still succumb to the lure of crime.

Over the past 2 months there have been reports of items stolen from parents' vehicles while they go to fetch their children after school, especially at the pre-primary school.

The most popular method of gaining access to items left in cars is the blocking of lock signals from remote devices. "Theft at Grey College is an ongoing concern, especially among the learners", says Tsio of Security for Grey College. Most of the incidents occur at the swimming pool or gym, when the owners let their guard down. Unfortunately the punishment for theft is only detention.

Learners must face the reality that leaving bags in open-access areas where there is no camera coverage is an open invitation to anyone inclined to theft.

Police are not involved as these issues are dealt with at the school. However, the Grey Security feels strongly that all cases of theft must be reported to the SAPS.

Finally it is and remains the responsibility of each learner and Grey visitor to ensure the safety of their belongings.

## Opinions divided on saga

### Variety of responses received on the Korkie-kidnapping

Three questions were asked of a number of respondents as to their impressions of the Korkie hostage situation and their responses were recorded and summarised. The questions were as follows:

- Do you think Mr Korkie's decision to sell up and take his family to Yemen was right?
- Should the SA government intervene to try and free him?
- Spiritually speaking, do you think he may have regrets?

To question 1, 70% of respondents feel he did the right thing; 35% believe it was not right and 5% are undecided. To question 2, 25% believe the SA government should provide financial aid; 65% believe they should not and 10% cannot decide. Finally, 30% feel that he may have regrets; 65% believe that he will not regret anything and 5% have no opinion.

Raul Henney and Jean Muller in grade 12 believe, "He followed his heart even though he knew there would be sacrifice involved", while

James Parsons feels, "Yemen is a single-religion country where it is illegal to preach different religions. Why take the risk?" Mothusi Ndou feels that, "Spiritually it's a yes, but in every other aspect it's a no."

Samkelo Fikizolo believes that he went to Yemen by choice and not in service to his country. He also feels that while spiritually it was a good deed, it was a bad decision because he was perhaps not fully aware of the dangers. Thabile Molelo believes that "If you regret your work for God, you have lost hope."



Volgens die onderwysers-organisasie Naptosa is die toename in rassistiese voorvalle by skole kommerwekkend. Louwrens Strydom, hoof van Naptosa in die Vrystaat en Noord-Kaap sê daar is gevalle waar die oorsprong eerder dissiplinêr as rassistiese van aard was.

Grey streef om 'n nie-rassistiese en 'n nie-diskriminerende omgewing vir alle leerders te skep. Enige vorm van diskriminasie op grond van ras of kleur wat indrus teen die kernwaarde van integriteit, menswaardigheid en

wedersydse respekte word ten sterke veroordeel word en daar sal opgetree word teen leerders wat hulle daaraan skuldig maak.

Professor Jonathan Jansen, rektor van die UV het 'n ope brief aan studente van die Universiteit van die Vrystaat gerig ná 'n beweerde rassevoorval op die kampus. Prof. Jansen pleit by studente om perspektief te behou en skryf: "Twee, tien of twintig studente se slegte gedrag verteenwoordig nie die gedrag van 30 000 studente nie."

Prof Jansen stel dit duidelik dat 'n minderheid van gewelddadige en haatdraende mense beslis nie die

ideale en ambisies van die meerderheid verteenwoordig nie. Grey Kollege het ook reeds gevorder op die pad van transformasie en het ons skool ook al bewys dat die negatiewe uitwerking van rassisme oorkom kan word.

Talle vriendskapsbande is al hier gesmee oor die grens van ras. Ons speel saam in sportspanne en verteenwoordig ons skool met trots. Mandala het gesê, "I like friends who have independent minds because they tend to make you see problems from all angles". Grey Kollege eer hierdie nalatenskap.

## Dink mooi voordat jy steroïedes gebruik

Dr Louis Holtzhausen, een van Suid-Afrika se mees gerespekteerde sportdokters verbonde aan die UV het onlangs die Grey-seuns toegespreek op 'n reguit, eerlike manier oor die werkelike risiko's van steroïedes en ander vorme van opkikkers. Grey het onlangs aangekondig dat hy toestem tot toetsing van leerders wat sport beoefen om te bepaal of hulle enigsins sulke middels gebruik.

Dr Holtzhausen het verduidelik dat die winkels wat die middels verkoop geensins omgee of help vir verbeterde sportprestasies nie; vir

hulle gaan dit net oor die geld aangesien die middels geweldig duur is. 'n Verdere verbasende onthulling was dat die baie duur proteïenpoerier wat baie mense gebruik nie soveel protein bevat as twee eiers nie; selfs melkpoerier bevat meer protein as die proteïenpoerier.

Die fisiese risiko's moet enige jong seun afskrik. Die werkelikhed is dat die geslagsdele aansienlik kan krimp; seuns kan borste ontwikkel; sal aknee kry - selfs op die rug en arme en hulle sal onbeheerbare aggressie en woede-aanvalle beleef.

Die middels kan ook lei tot onomkeerbare onvrugbaarheid. Dr Holtzhausen het interessante feite

vertel van Duitse soldate wat met bulaad ingesput is om hulle agressie en spierkrug in die Tweede Wêreldoorlog te bevorder. Heidi Krieger, 'n voormalige Oos-Duitse Olimpiëeleteet het weens die oormaat testosteroon wat sy ingeneem het, klein testes ontwikkel en sy moes uiteindelik 'n geslagsverandering ondergaan.

Hoekom word dit dan steeds gebruik? Die waarskynlikste is dat dit toegeskryf kan word aan toenemende druk van ouers en afrigers om te presteer, groepsdruk of selfs 'n verwronge begeerte om beter te wees as waartoe die mens normaalweg fisies in staat is.

Die invloed wat mediaberigte en foto's, flikeks en rekenaarspeletjies op die onrealistiese verwagtinge van 'n seun het, mag ook nooit onderskat word nie. Vele ontwikkelende seuns is miskien skaam vir hulle gebrek aan indrukwekkende spiere en word dan verleid deur "quick-fixes".

Enige seun wat hoor van al die gevare verbonde aan die gebruik van die middels en steeds aanhou om dit te gebruik, sal hopellik na Dr Holtzhausen se praatje besef dat hy eintlik sy lewe in gevare stel.

Geen groepsdruk of hunger na prestasie en voorkoms behoort enige regdenkende mens na sulke uiterstes te dryf nie.

Volgens me Lettie van Wyk, hoof van redenaars en debat, was dit die meeste inskrywings nog.

Na elke spreker sy mening gelug het, word hy deur die beoordelaar aangespreek oor enige aspekte waar hy kon verbeter. "In Skoolronde is waardevol want dit

is 'n goeie ysbreker om die sprekers gewoon te maak aan die redenaarsopset, beoordelaars en gehoor," sê Niel Bezuidenhout, matriekleerdeerder en senior spreker wat al op nasionalevlak deelgeneem het.

Volgens Niel help redenaars leerders om belangrike vaardighede te ontwikkel, soos om krities oor aktuele sake te dink. "Deur aan redenaars deel te neem kry jy die geleentheid en leer om voor mense op te tree en ontwikkel jy selfvertroue," sê me Van Wyk.

Me van Wyk voel baie positief

oor die kwaliteit van redenaars, omdat elke spreker gemaklik mense kan oortuig van 'n standpunt. Daar is ook elke jaar leerders wat vorder tot by die provinsiale ronde.

"Die skoolronde sal verseker dat sprekers gereed is vir die ATKV-kompetisies, dat redenaars baie sal verbeter en sprekers meer sal ontwikkel," sê Francois Venter, afrigter en beoordelaar van Grey redenaars en debat.

Me Van Wyk meen dit was hoogtyd dat die skool 'n interne ronde hou want dit berei sprekers voor, sodat hulle nie die eerste keer

by die streeksronde voor mense praat nie.

"Die land het 'n tekort aan mense wat hul mening en standpunt op 'n logiese wyse kan oor bring, mense wat hulle sê kan sê en mense daarvan oortuig. Dit is die motivering agter die redenaarsklub; die land kort redenaars om apatie en belangloosheid teen te werk en om leerders reg te leer praat," sê Niel.

It is redenaars se missie om die vaardigheid van openbare redevoering en debattering te bevorder. Volgens me Van Wyk word die missie bereik.



There are almost seven hours of school in a full school day; seven hours most of us would prefer to avoid. Despite this there are still learners who take extra classes and spend more time at school. Do they actually enjoy school, or do they have some other reason?

According to a grade 11 learner, "It's not that I enjoy school, I just want to do better." Several other learners had a similar response. Most of these learners take extra mathematics or science classes. ## Hoë brandstofprys ry toere in die wiele



seuns meen as sy seuns eerder sondagoggend vroeg by die huis kan aankom, kan hulle die heeldag aan hul akademiese werk aandag gee. Nico Prinsloo wonder "hoe kom slaap ons oor en spander R200 – R400 per persoon ekstra terwyl meeste kerries om eerder deur die nag te ry?" Die reël is net gebaseer op leerderveiligheid.

Mnr Scheepers sê: "n Mens kan nie finansies aan 'n Grey-seun se lewe koppel nie." Daar is baie ander faktore soos bv. die tyd van die

## The why and wherefor of subject changes in grade 12

Many grade 12 learners are now deciding to make subject changes in what is hopefully their final year. The question is, why now?

Some learners have found certain subjects to be irrelevant in the field of study they wish to pursue, others have lost interest in the subject but the most prominent reason is that learners feel they won't be able to cope with the level of work of the CAPS syllabus for these subjects.

Two subjects that have been traded the most are Mathematics for Mathematical Literacy, and Physical Sciences. With the implementation of the CAPS syllabus the standard of work and regulations has increased to such a degree that some learners find it almost impossible to cope with the higher standard of work.

The reason for the new syllabus is to allow a higher better standard of work for the universities. These new regulations mean that previously struggling students will now find it even more difficult to meet with the standard of work. Jamie Grobbelaar in grade 12 said that he had changed Life Sciences for Geography and Technical Drawing for Business Studies. He said the reason for this change was "I found it difficult to cope with the level of work in all my subjects and be able to maintain the same level of effort in every subject."

Some learners also moved to different educators in January because they find it easier to work under certain circumstances presented by different educators. Other learners have grown used to associating a subject with a certain teacher and would find it easier to continue working with that specific teacher.

## Fischertrust dra leerders steeds

*Grey herdenk Madiba se stigting van studiefonds vir behoeftige leerders*

Presies 72 jaar nadat advokaat Bram Fischer, gewese leier van die Suid-Afrikaanse Kommunistiese Party in 1925 aan Grey Kollege in Bloemfontein gematrikuleer het, is hy op 28 November 1997 by sy alma mater vereer toe oud-pres. Nelson Mandela 'n gedenktrustfonds vir minderbevoordekte kinders en toekomstige leiers ter ere van hom bekend gestel het.

Fischer was 'n lid van die verdedigingspan in die 1964 Rivonia-verhoor, waarin Nelson Mandela weens hoogverraad lewenslange tronkstraf gekry het. Fischer, die breinkrug agter die feit dat Mandela se lewe gespaar is, het self in 1966 lewenslange tronkstraf gekry weens sameswering tot sabotasie.

Nadat hy met kanker gediagnoseer is, is hy in 1974 vrygelaat om by sy broer, in Bloemfontein, sy laaste jare deur te bring. Hy sterf in Mei 1975 in sy broer se huis in President Reitzlaan, Westdene.

'n Broerskind, adv Pieter Fischer, van Bloemfontein het gesê dat "die hoofdoel van die fonds is om minderbevoordekte seuns met akademiese- of sport-potensiaal te help om aan Grey te studeer."

Die plan om Fischer te vereer, het ontstaan toe oud-premier Patrick Lekota in 1996 op 'n onthaal in Grey se Reüniesaal ter viering van die SAKP se 75ste bestaansjaar voorgestel het dat dat iets ter herdenking van Fischer gedoen sou word.

Lekota was in daardie stadium op Grey se Beheerraad, 'n Trustfonds

is geregistreer, waarvan Patrick Lekota, Pieter Fischer en ander lede van die Grey Reünie onder andere trustees is.

Met sy versoenende toespraak by die bekendstelling van die Bram Fischer-gedenktrust, sy Afrikaanse aksent wat hom, soos hyself gesê het "soos 'n tokkelossie laat klink", 'n hoesie waarmee hy die gehoor se simpatie gehad het en Madibahemp het Mandela diep in die harte van die Grey-seuns in Bloemfontein ingekruip. "Madiba is our hero!" het hulle hom in 'n volgepakte Reüniesaal toegesing, daarna hulle war cry geskree en die plankvloer laat dreun het.

Daar was sterk kritiek oor die Madiba-besoek aan Grey. Die Vryheidfront het beswaar gemaak dat "leerlinge wat hulle nie met hierdie politieke verering van die SAKP kan vereenzelwig nie, geen keuse gehad het as om die seremonie by te woon nie." Mnr Johan Volsteedt het in kommentaar gesê dat "niemand gedwing is om die plegtigheid by te woon nie."

In 2014 het 5 seuns vol- of gedeeltelike beurse uit die Bram Fischer-trust ontvang. Mnr Johan Volsteedt is van mening dat: "die waarde van die trust veral daarin lê dat Grey aan die voortuin van opvoeding en onderrig bly."

Die volhoubaarheid van die trust sal bepaal word deur die bydraes van Oud-Greys, ouers en maatskappye wat die waarde van Grey vir die Vrystaat en Suid-Afrika beseef.

"Education is the most powerful weapon to change the world." Grey vereer Mandela vir hierdie woorde.

Many factors lead to the choice one has to make regarding which tertiary institution to choose. Bradon de Witt a grade 11 learner jokingly said, "I want to go somewhere I can party." People want to go to a university where they can enjoy themselves but also get a degree and learn skills that will help them in life.

South Africa is blessed with a number of good universities. Bloemfontein has three universities: the Central University of Technology, the University of the Free State and Vista University. According to the QS 2013 world rankings, the University of Cape Town is 145th in the world, Wits 313th and Stellenbosch is 387th - the three highest ranked South African universities. UCT is ranked the best university in Africa and Wits is the university in South Africa whose alumni earn the highest salary. Your university of choice has much to do with the course that you plan on studying as

certain universities are better to go to than others for specific courses. The University of the Free State is ranked highly for their medical and architectural faculties.

Where a matriculant chooses to study should depend on what he wants to study, the price and the reputation of the university. If students cannot afford to pay university fees they can take out a low interest loan. Banks tend to charge lower interest on student

loans than on other loans and the students can start paying the loans back when they start working. One can apply for a bursary as many institutions offer bursaries. It is not easy to obtain a bursary and one must do well academically or excel on the sports field to have a realistic chance of getting one. First year fees at the University of Pretoria range from R27400-R48550. This is just an indication of how expensive studying can be.



*Is the time slot of assembly weakening the once famous spirit of Grey?*



Muurbal het in Suid-Afrika posgevat tydens die 20ste eeu deur die invloed van die Britse Militêre magte. Die eerste bane is by die Johannesburg Country Club en Pretoria Squash Club gebou en was wyer en langer as die huidige moderne bane.

Sedert 1925 het muurbal in gewildheid begin toeneem en in 1930 word die baan verander na die huidige grootte en ook onder dak geplaas. Hierdie bane is gebou in Durban en Kaapstad. So vroeg as 1910 het Suid-Afrika reeds die eerste land ter wêreld geword wat 'n nasionale beheerliggaam vir muurbal gestig het.

Muurbal bied uitstekende kadiovaskulêre oefening en is in 2003 deur Forbes Magazine aangewys as die gesondste sport om te speel. Die gewilheid van die sportsoort kan sekerlik toegeskryf word aan die feit dat dit 'n baie goeie manier is om jou hele liggaam 'n goeie "work-out" te gee en dat jy binne een uur ongeveer 600 – 1000 kalorieë (3 000 – 4 000 kJ) kan verbrand.

Mnr Fanie Reynders is sedert 2013 die hoof van muurbal. Volgens hom was die afgelope toernooi by St Andrews baie moeilik, omdat die span bestaan uit baie jong spelers. In South Africa Grey College can be regarded as probably the best-known school when sport in general is mentioned. The school maintains a very high level of performance in rugby, cricket and hockey. Can the same be said of water polo?
