The 2013 Free State Kunswedstryd proved to be a journey of triumph for Grey. Apart from individual entries, Grey also entered the choir, Indomitus, marimba groups, the ensemble and the Boere-orke in this competition.

This prelude to the competition was gruelling for the teachers and the boys and practice sessions were held every day, for several hours. However, these sessions and weekend training camps paid off well as the groups collected an excellent crop of results.

All the groups entered won A++ symbols and ms Joanie Prinsloo, head of music at Grey believes that, "the boys feed on positive comments and this simply spurs them on to greater heights." An undeniable result is also, "an increased spirit of unity and a desire to excel even more," believes ms Celeste Venter, conductor of the ensemble.

Notification was received that the Grey choir is the 2013 best choir in the Free State; Indomitus is the best singing group in the Free State and Paul Loeb van Zuilenberg and Chris du Toit were recognised as respectively the best violinist and the best cellist in the province. Martin Claassen won the title of best woodwind musician.

This is the first time in the history of Grey College that this consistent level of excellence was maintained.

Mr Christo van Rensburg, music teacher and accompanist believes that this is due only to, "an incredible amount of hard work, patience, talent and co-operation amongst all involved."

Grey-seuns Niel Bezuidenhout, Vince de Beer, Hardus Labuschagne en Julius Zerwick het dié woorde gestand gedoen tydens die semi-finale ronde van die ATKV se redenaars- en debat-kompetisie, wat op 17 en 18 Mei in Bethlehem plaasgevind het. Die Grey seuns was bevoorreg om in Mei 2013 tydens saalperiode vir Shéri Brynard, bekende motivering-spreker by Grey Kollege te verwelkom.

Shéri is intellektueel gestrem. Sy is 'n Down-sindroom persoon en, anders as in die meeste gevalle, is sy nie net gedeeltelik aangetas nie. Elke sel in haar liggaam het 'n ekstra chromosoom. Niks kan haar gestremtheid verander nie en daarom moet sy binne hierdie konteks en beperkings gesien word.

Sy is die eerste leerder met

Down-sindroom wat aan Hoërskool Martie du Plessis toegelaat is en in 2000 slaag sy die beroepsgerigte gr 10 (Nasionale Sertifikaat). Die feit dat sy soms meer as een keer gedruip het, het haar nie laat opgee nie. In 2009 behaal sy die N6-kursus aan die Motheo Tegniese Kollege. Sy is die enigste leerder met Down-sindroom wat nog ooit aan die kollege toegelaat is. Dit maak haar dan die enigste leerder met Down-sindroom Suid-Afrika wat 'n nasionale diploma behaal.

Shéri werk as onderwys-assistent by Lettie Fouché skool vir gestremdes en tree oral in die land

en in die buiteland op. Sy het onlangs by die internasionale Down-sindroom kongres in New York 'n toespraak gelewer.

Shéri is trots om te wees wie sy is, 'n persoon met Down-sindroom. Sy beklemtoon dat "prestasie word aan jouself gemeet en nie aan 'n ander nie". Die wyse waarop die seuns haar staande toegejuig het bewys dat hulle begrip en respek het vir haar woorde, "n Wonderlike pianis het by geleentheid gesê dat daar nie iets soos 'n vals noot is nie. Die note mag dalk vir ons verkeerd klink maar in werklikheid klink dit net anders".

Onlangse besprekings in die personeelkamer was gefokus op die kleredrag van beide leerders en onderwysers tydens toere. Om te bepaal wat die nuwe regulasies behels, is vroeër gerig aan verskeie betrokkenes.

Eben von Gericke in graad 11 meen, "Ja, almal dink dat die 'nuwe' reëls sleg is, maar eintlik is die reëls nog altyd ingestel. Baie minder aandag was aan hulle gegee, en mnr Scheepers het die skool net weer ingelig wat die reëls nog altyd was."

Die meeste van die seuns het gesê hulle sou eerder in die skool se sweetpak reis; verskeie het bygevoeg dat dit netjies lyk wanneer die skooluniform gedra word.

Daar word ook oorweeg om saam met Eunice en ander skole vakke soos bv. Drama, Kunste en Visuele Kunste aan te bied.

Indien belangstelling nie 'n klas regverdig nie, kan dit buitemuurs aangebied word.

Alle ouers sal op die hoogte gehou word van verdere ontwikkelings in die verband.

Adriaan Strauss se aksies spreek selfs nog duideliker as sy woorde

Met 'n volle 111kg en 'n lengte van 1,84m staan hy sy skoene vol; 'n sagmoedige dog selfversekerde reus met die hart van 'n leeu. Adriaan Strauss, oud-Grey en Springbok rugbyspeler draf uit as haker en kaptein vir die Vrystaat Toyota Cheetahs in die Curriebeker en Super-rugby kompetisies.

Hierdie oud-onderskoolkaptein van 2003 het daarop gewys dat die klein dingetjies die lewe die moeite werd maak, die klein dingetjies wat herinneringe bou wat jy na skool sal saamneem. Hy glo dat 'n mens ook die groot oomblikke in die lewe moet geniet. Elke seun moet die geleentheid wat Grey hom bied aangryp. Interskole-naweke, soos dié met Affies, durf nie as

vanselfsprekend aanvaar word nie want daar is min dinge na skool wat daardie "butterflies" gee. Hy het verder 'n ernstige beroep op die seuns gedoen om betrokke te wees en mekaar te ondersteun - nie omdat jy moet nie, maar omdat jy wil.

Strauss meen het hy al die geleentheid in sy lewe grootliks aan Grey te danke. Die potensiaal wat op die skoolgronde rondloop, is verstommend en hy is oortuig dat die gesamentlike potensiaal van die Grey manne berge kan versit. Te midde van alle onvermydelike veranderinge, glo hy dat die die Grey 'gees' nooit sal verander nie. Sy loopbaan was vol hoogtepunte waarvan Grey se oorwinning teen Paul Roos in sy matriekjaar altyd sal uitstaan; sodoende het hulle daardie jaar onoorwonne afgesluit.

Die ongelooflike leierskap wat Strauss openbaar as kaptein van die Cheetahs, sowel as destydse onderskoolkaptein is klinkklare bewys daarvan dat die volbring van 'n man se potensiaal op homself berus.

First black learner addresses assembly on Freedom Day

As part of Freedom Day celebrations, on Thursday 25 April 2013 Grey College had a Freedom Day-themed assembly. Three Grey College staff members, Mrs Hester Roos, Mr Craig Steyn and Mr Naresh Mahabeer, each from a different generation, delivered speeches on

their idea of what freedom is and what Freedom Day means to them.

Felix Mokoena, currently a member of the school governing body, matriculated from Grey in 1997 as the school's first black student. Felix, who was a prefect elected by fellow Grey boys of the time, addressed the assembly. He described his first day at Grey and he

also described how it was to be the only black student in a teeming ocean of white faces at the time. He remembers looking around him and feeling utterly isolated, yet realising that in order to secure a better life for himself he would have to persevere.

Mokoena understood that using his freedom was his own responsibility, and therein lies a

valuable lesson.

On Friday 26 April 2013 the Grey boys walked to the Free State stadium. Malelo Mweemba, grade 9, believes that the celebrations could have been better organised. As he says, "All we experienced was food, flags and a show which did not really commemorate Freedom Day."

Unite to stop the erosion of a venerable tradition

The essence of Grey is conveyed in the powerful lyrics of our school's song, an anthem that has been part of our tradition for many years. It is there to create an atmosphere of unity and pride in our school and should be sung with respect and zeal. It is a legacy we must hold in high esteem.

However, lately it would appear that learners have lost the respect this venerable tradition deserves and that very little attention is given to this important aspect of Grey's heritage. Especially the younger grades do not always respect the school song. It has become a chore

rather than a privilege and an honour, and this is noticeable in the lack of passion and gusto when the anthem is sung during the assembly period.

The majority of the younger pupils do not seem to know all the lyrics and many verses are heard as a mumble. In addition, learners do not stand up straight, hands are not held respectfully at their sides and learners pull faces, grimace and look around while haphazardly staring around them to see where alternative entertainment might lie. This is very embarrassing to hear in the presence of guest speakers. Very little enthusiasm is shown. Where is the spirit? Where is the

pride in the school anthem? Where is the sense of unity and belonging? Whether out of ignorance or out of disregard, this is an issue of respect and very serious attention is needed to resurrect this tradition. Singing our school song is an occasion that demands all Grey boys should come up to scratch.

Nevertheless, whatever the reason, a solution to this problem must be arrived at. Does the answer lie in extended periods of singing in the hall prior to the actual assembly, or does the answer present itself in healing and rejuvenating the attitude of the learners; the so-called 'gees' which seems to be sadly lacking?

Stabilis spoke to a number of learners in this regard and Nkhiseng Relepel in grade 11 perfectly summarised the general feeling amongst learners. He believes as follows, "Firstly, learners must again consider their pride in the institution they attend and the inherent tradition they also accepted."

This would imply that every learner should realise that the responsibility of reflecting pride in their school lies with them and as such, show that pride when you sing the school anthem: "Staan ons Grey Kollege heg en sterk, beroemd vir spel en goeie werk..."

Korkie family taken hostage in Yemen

Pierre Korkie was a Biology teacher at Grey College for more than 20 years, and in that time he impressed colleagues and learners alike with his hard work, reputation for fairness and the passion he had for helping lesser-privileged people. It is precisely this passion that led him to bid Grey farewell and emigrate to Yemen with his family. Mr Korkie, his wife Yolande as well as his 2 children left South Africa at the end of 2009 after which they went to Yemen to work for the NGO, Rafah Foundation for Development.

Mr Korkie returned to Grey for a brief visit two years later, and he told of the hardships they encountered and the suffering that they wished to alleviate. It was thus with shock that the world learned of the abduction of Pierre Korkie, his wife and their children from a hotel in the city of Taiz. The Korkie family were apparently on their way to South Africa for the funeral of Mr Korkie's father in Port Elizabeth when the abduction occurred.

The children have allegedly been released and are safe at an undisclosed location, and it is speculated that the abductors mistook the South African couple for Europeans or Americans. No demands which could lead to their release have been issued and no negotiations have been entered into.

Any speculation that a branch of Al Qaeda could have been responsible for this crime is discouraged as this could complicate the situation; however, the department of foreign affairs is monitoring the situation.

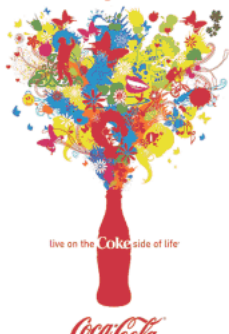

Families can be colleagues, and this is evident at Grey. We have the Cronjé brothers and son, the Venter brother and sister and also Mrs Louise Pretorius and her son Stephan – better known as mr Putu. Mrs Pretorius started at Grey in 1985 as a supply teacher.

She was involved on and off but was appointed in a permanent position after the passing of her husband. Dr Michau Heyns, principal at the time, was compassionate of her situation as she had three children to raise. "Grey was my haven at that stage and it came at the right time", says Mrs Pretorius.

"Working with my mother is great. I enjoy seeing her every day and I have so much love and respect for her; she coped wonderfully as a single parent", says Mr Pretorius. His mother claims that she calls him by his real name, Stephan.

Also an old-Grey, Mr Pretorius has been at Grey College for seven years and teaching here was the obvious choice. "There has been a change in the boys over the years", says Mr Pretorius. "The boys aren't as loyal as the older boys were, but the new generation really works hard. My experience at Grey has been wonderful."

Mr Pretorius realised that a sedentary career was not for him after he had a desk job in England. He is also a part-time preacher for the Towers of Hope congregation, and he and his wife Eunice work hard in outreach and upliftment amongst people who have lost their way in life. Even from behind the pulpit, Mr Pretorius has proved himself to be a dedicated 'teacher'.

With the birth of the Pretorius couple's son Willem, Mrs Pretorius's first grandchild, the possibility exists that the legacy of teaching could perhaps continue. Given the fact

that he has such excellent role models, this is not impossible.

Teaching is a privilege for mother and son, but the profession has enormous challenges. There never seems to be enough time to make sure that the syllabus has been covered.

Their unique relationship as colleagues is professional and it is important to them never to embarrass each other. "I am proud to see that my son has developed into a true professional. He has also realised that what I said is true: once Grey has you, it won't let go."

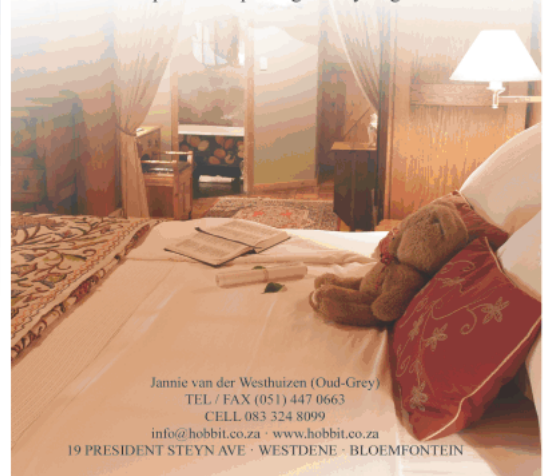

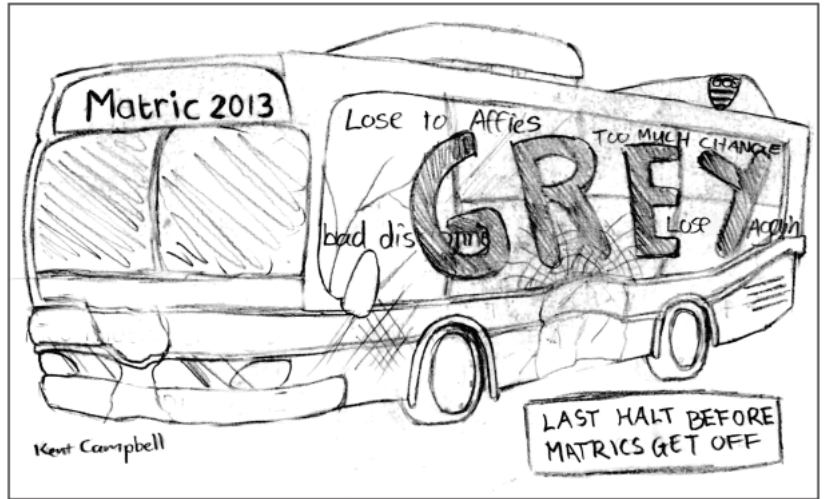

More subjects, more options, wider choices

During an assembly earlier this month, Mr P. Wessels announced the school's planned introduction of more subjects, namely Sesotho, Economics, Sports Sciences, Civil Technology and Tourism. There is also an intended option of learners being allowed to offer both English and Afrikaans on home language level, under certain conditions and after due consideration.

The idea behind this is that by broadening the subject choice of students, the marketing appeal of the school will increase as many outsiders feel that Grey College is a school only for learners interested in sports and thus, caters mostly to the needs of such students. DJ Basson, a grade 10 learner, says, "The new subjects don't really affect me personally. I think it would be great for the school to expand and diversify the subject choices. These subjects would definitely raise the level of interest in the school and learners would be able to enjoy their subjects more."

The implementation of the subjects is based on the level of interest from the learners in the particular subject. If the interest is adequate, then it will be introduced as a mainstream subject (subjects that are part of the standard school day). If the level of interest is not sufficient, it might be introduced as an extra subject. If there is a very low level of interest in the subject, then it is possible that the subject will not be available next year.

Mr Wessels states that, "A similar survey might be held every few years to continuously test the level of interest for the possible introduction of even more subjects."

Trusts is steunpilaar vir toekoms

Jock Meiring- en Bram Fischer-trusts lewer groot bydrae tot skool se groei

Baie Grey-seuns loop gedurende poue met die geplaveide paadjie langs na Grey Together. Almal het seker al die nuut-geboude kantoor, op die hoek van die museum met mnr. Johan Volsteed agter die lessenaar en die Grey-wapen op die venster, opgemerk.

Wie weet egter regtig wat die Jock Meiring- en Bram Fischertrust is? Die Jock Meiringtrust is vernoem na John Murray (Jock) Meiring en is in 1973 gestig. Meiring, wat in Winburg gematrikuleer het, het as 'n

jong onderwyser met baie planne en entoesiasme na Grey gekom. Hy is in 1922 aangewys as prinsipaal en het dadelik die noodsaaklikheid van 'n laerskool en 'n nuwe koshuis besef.

Ook in later jare het hy gehelp met die daartelling van 'n "kindergarten" by Grey. Daarom is die Jock Meiringtrust gestig, met die doel om fondse in te samel vir die instandhouding en verbetering van fasiliteite by die skool. Die trust beplan om in die nabye toekoms die vervanging van die Astro-mat en die herstelwerk van sekere skoolgeboue te finansier.

Die geboue by College Square word op 'n langtermyn-basis aan verskeie maatskappye verhuur. Die inkomste gaan na die Jock Meiringtrust en word gebruik vir projekte op die terrein. Die Bram Fischertrust het weer 'n heeltemal ander doel voor oë. Dié trust beywer hom daarvoor om aan seuns wat finansiële sukkel ook 'n geleentheid by Grey te bied.

Die trust hanteer ook die fondse van die Grey Absa-akademie. Dit impliseer dat bydraes tot dié trust vir maatskappye "BEE"-punte kan verwerf. Die trust is in 1997, met die

samewerking van oudpresident Nelson Mandela, in die lewe geroep en is vernoem na 'n beroemde oudskolier, Abram Louis Fischer. Hy het in 1925 gematrikuleer en was 'n student aan die Universiteit van Oxford.

Hy is veral bekend vir die Rivonia-verhoor in 1964 en het diep spore in Suid-Afrika se stryd teen apartheid getrap. Beide trusts is baie suksesvol en donasies van oud-Greys, van maatskappye, asook van persone oorsee word gereeld ontvang. Talle projekte lê in die vooruitsig.

Mystery of the missing school captain

The absence of a name on the boards inside the Reunie Hall under past school captains is apparent in 1928. This absence was noted by chance by one of the current learners during a hall period.

It appears that there is no record of a school captain in 1928 and with Old Greys from this time

being very few and hard to find this may just remain an unsolved mystery for the rest of time for Grey College.

With a search being led by previous headmaster of Grey College, Johan Volsteed, an attempt to recover this information is being made. So far Dr Barry Fichardt and prominent Old Grey Edwin Grant could also not shed any

light on the matter.

According to the 1928 magazine there was no school captain and in the magazine it is joked that possibly no one was considered good enough to lead the school in that year. The exact wording in the 1928 magazine reads as follows: "Perhaps they do not advocate a school captain in 'twenty-eight'; Doubtless there is some candidate for captaincy. The need so great as to occasion a long wait; Until he's in a fitter state - the captain to become." It continues as follows: "Perhaps in 'twenty-nine we'll see a captain who is quite worthy of gaining rank of captaincy; A noble type of boy will he, the future captain have to be. I think they ought to pick on me - the captain to become."

A scholar at Grey noticed the absence of the name towards the end of May 2013. He then enquired who the school captain was in that year and with no one able to answer his question the search for the missing school captain began.

According to the magazine the question can be raised whether something went wrong in 1928, disqualifying the school captain elected for that year. It is interesting that the principal, Jock Meiring, did not mention it at all in his annual report for the year.

The 'system' will not prepare you

Life after school needs thorough preparation and the current education system is structured to prepare learners for their careers. The high rate of first year university dropouts leads to one critical question: Does the current education system in South Africa provide enough opportunities for learners to maximize their potential?

At Grey more subjects might be taught in future, namely; Economics, Sports and Exercise Science and Civil Technology. This creates more opportunities for Grey boys.

Are all of these opportunities sufficient for future success? "Academic success does not

guarantee success after school," says Mrs Esta Hattingh, psychologist at Grey College. Why? It is because secondary schools do not fully prepare learners for life after school. High schools tend to spoon-feed learners. This blocks the ability of the learner to be creative.

In most universities the Socratic method is used for teaching; this method uses asking questions based on what is already known by the students. The method aims at deepening understanding of that particular subject.

The education system of SA accommodates all learners in SA, but improvement is still needed to effectively prepare learners to be the best they can be.

SA is geskikte plek vir neem van landspoed-rekord

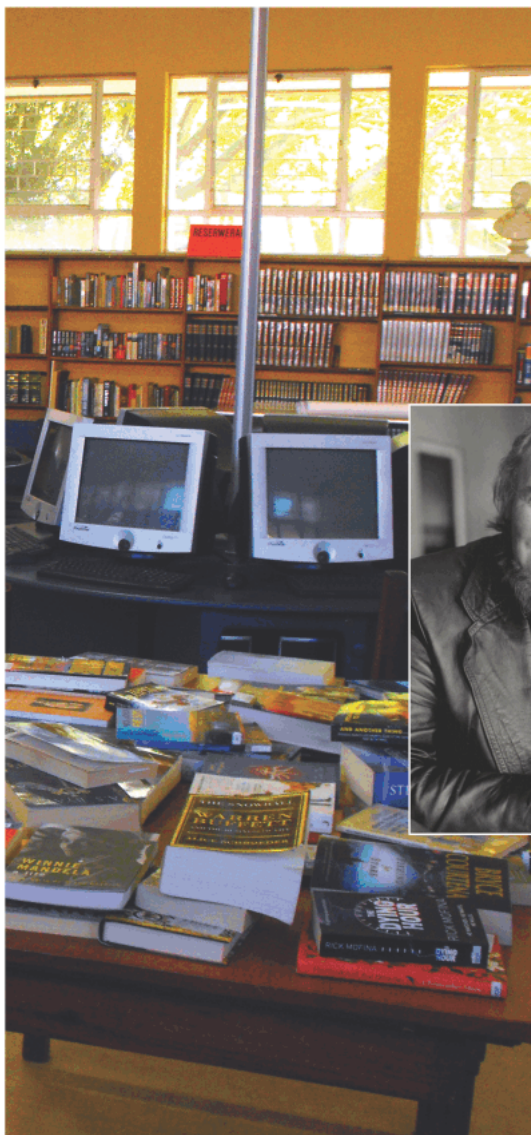

Volgende jaar, as alles goed gaan, sal Suid-Afrika die gasheer wees vir 'n nuwe landspoedrekord. Die Bloodhound SSC (supersoniese motor) is 'n vuurpymotor wat aanstaande jaar in Hakskeenpan in die Noord-Kaap 'n rekord gaan probeer opstel vir die vinnigste spoed wat nog ooit op land bereik is. Die rekordpoging word aangepak deur Andy Green.

Hakskeenpan is gekies weens die plat en wye oppervlak. 'n Span van 317 werklose mense in die omgewing het reeds 'n rekord opgestel vir hierdie gebeurtenis deur sowat 22 miljoen vierkante meter heeltemal skoon te maak sodat daar nie 'n enkele klip in Green se pad sal wees nie. Sowat 6 000 ton klippe is verwyder. Die gebied is 1,3 km wyd en 20 km lank, gelykstaande aan 3000 sokkervelde.

Die motor sal 'n spoed van 1600 km/h bereik en dit binne 3,6 sekondes. Dit is ongeveer 1,4 keer vinniger as die spoed van klank en vinniger as die spoed van 'n koeël wat deur 'n Magnum .357 afgevuur word. Die motor sal sy eie lengte in minder as drie honderdstes van 'n sekonde aflê. Die supersone motor is 13,5 meter lank en 2,8 meter hoog en weeg sowat 7,5 ton. Die enjin van die motor produseer sowat 135 000 perdekrag, gelykstaande aan die krag van 180 Formule Een-renmotors. Die Bloodhound se eksterne oppervlak sal 'n temperatuur van tussen 150°C en 175°C bereik en die binnekant sal 3000°C word.

Daar sal sowat 40 tot 50 laespoedtoetsritte (1 368 km per uur) op die motor uitgevoer word teen April, Mei en Junie 2014. Die projek het naastenby R260 miljoen gekos.

nie, of die voorraad is verouderd. Dit is gelukkig nie die geval by Grey nie. Alhoewel die oorheersende opinie dalk is dat die biblioteek nie meer gebruik word nie, word dit steeds vir 'n verskeidenheid doeleindes gebruik. Me. Susara Fourie (hoof van die biblioteek) sê die volgende: "Ek

dink nie die biblioteek word pouses minder as in die verlede gebruik nie. Daar is dikwels leerders wat die rekenars gebruik. Ander kom gou die koerante deurblaai en dié wat graag lees, kom neem 'n boek uit."

Die biblioteek is ook nie volgestop met verouderde boeke nie. Grey is bevoorreg dat daar op 'n jaarlikse basis nuwe boeke aangekoop word om die rakke mee te vul. Volgens me. Fourie is daar heelwat van die jongste gepubliseerde boeke in die biblioteek te vinde.

Die kwaliteit van die biblioteek kan dus geensins as 'n rede

voorgehou word om nie die biblioteek te besoek nie. Daar is natuurlik wel leerders wat nooit in hul skoolloopbaan die biblioteek besoek nie, omdat hulle nie graag lees nie.

Die biblioteek word wel nie meer soveel vir navorsingsdoelendes gebruik nie. Quentin Campbell (biblioteekprefek) verduidelik dit as volg: "Met die gerieflikheid van die internet en die maklike toegang daarna word die biblioteek nie meer vir navorsing gebruik nie. Dit is baie vinniger, geriefliker en makliker om op 'n selfoon navorsing te doen."

Alhoewel die meeste navorsing op 'n elektroniese vlak plaasvind, is 'n biblioteek steeds belangrik vir 'n skool. Me. Fourie som dit baie mooi op: " 'n Biblioteek is die intellektuele barometer van die skool. En natuurlik presteer lesers beter in alle akademiese werk as nie-lesers."

Ten spyte van 'n tyd van selfone en die internet, kom Grey se biblioteek steeds funksioneer soos dit vroeër kon. Daar is baie min skoolbiblioteke wat op só 'n vlak kan groei, en dit moet nie as vanselfsprekend aanvaar word nie.

Die biblioteek is ook vir baie navorsers 'n belangrike bron van inligting. Die kosbare Grey-boekversameling sluit onder andere werke en notas van bekende oud-Grey-skrywers in. Min skole kan spog met drie Hertzogprys-wenners in sy gelede.

By Grey is daar CM van den Heever, WA de Klerk en Etienne Leroux. Leroux is seker die bekendste van hulle met twee Hertzogpryse - een vir "Sewe dae by die Silbersteins" en nog een vir "Magersfontein, o Magersfontein".

Grey se biblioteek is 'n sieraad en behoort so gesien te word.

Some of the problems that have surfaced are Blackberry's failure to continue its B.I.S. service which offered an unlimited amount of Internet usage for R60 a month and many are complaining about the battery life of the phones as the devices age. Therefore many people have decided to switch to rivals Apple and Samsung, favoring the touch screen devices that run on iOS and Android operating systems, respectively.

Blackberry has had an attempt at a revival with the introduction of the new Blackberry 10 software which features on the new Blackberry Z10 and Q10. Many people have praised Blackberry CEO Thorsten Heinz' decision to release BBM on rival platform Android and iOS later this year. In the Canadian company's heyday stock prices



exceeded \$200 per share compared to the \$14.48 it trades at now.

Kyle Tessner, a grade 10 learner, said "Compared to rivals Samsung and Apple, Blackberry doesn't come up to scratch, but bringing BBM to the AppStore and Android Market would be a good idea for Blackberry to survive financially." Like many learners in Grey College Tessner made the switch from Blackberry to Samsung.

The Blackberry team will need a large amount of ingenuity to regain the market share it once had. Many analysts suggest that Blackberry's future growth potential lies in developing markets such as Nigeria.

Blackberry might need a miracle to be at the pinnacle of smartphone technology again and regain its status as the most dominant smartphone company. We just might yet see a surprise or will Blackberry be another company that could not keep up with the fast pace of the cruel and ever-changing world we live in?

Grey steeds enigste onoorwonne Wildeklawer-span

Die vyfde jaarlikse Wildeklawer superskole-toernooi het op Donderdag, 2 Mei afgeskop. Dié toernooi, wat vanjaar op die velde van Maritzburg College in Pietermaritzburg gehou is, is bekend vir sy hoë gehalte skolerugby, waar 18 van die land se beste rugbyskole teen mekaar meeding.

Grey het kort na die afskop van die eerste wedstryd die voortou geneem toe Stephen Rautenbach 'n strafdoel deur die pale gestuur het. Dit is vinnig gevolg deur 'n drie van Oakdale en die eerste helfte het baie gelykop verloop. Die rustydteiling was inderdaad 13-13. In die tweede helfte het die eerstespan na 'n hoër

rat oorgeskakel en drieë deur Heinrich Sander, EW Viljoen, Julian Jordaan en Andries Kriek het die Grey-manne se voorsprong vinnig laat klim. Later in die tweede helfte het Marius Louw en Carel Durow albei 'n slag onder die pale gaan kuier. Twee minute voor die einde van die wedstryd het Oakdale egter 'n drie gedruk om 'n finale telling van 42-20, in Grey se guns, te verseker.
