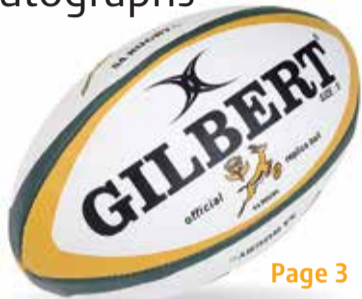

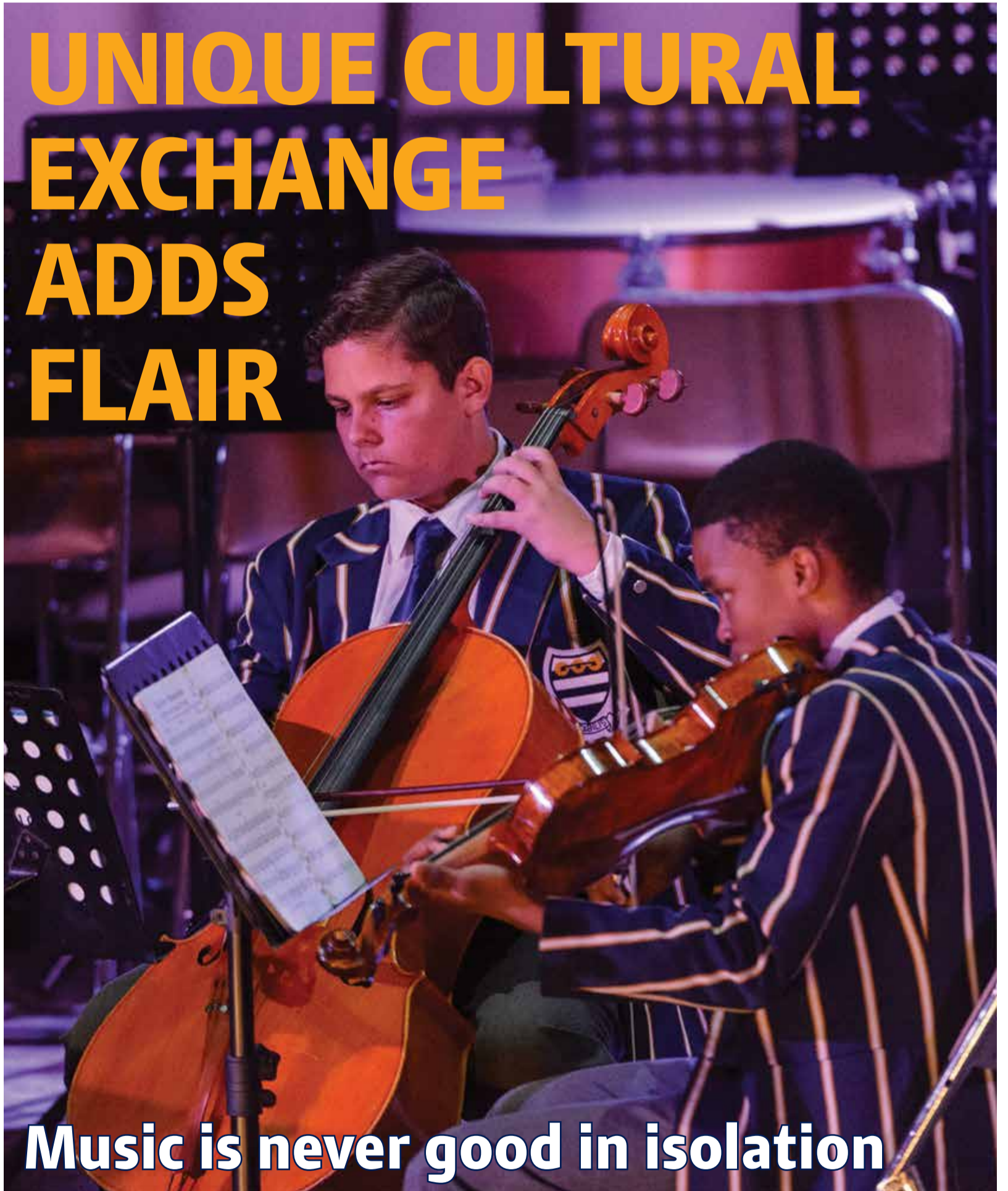

Maak toe die gat in die vraestel-dam

Leerders het tydens die Junie-eksamen interne vraestelle geskryf in plaas van die departementele vraestelle wat verskaf is.

Die Jaarlikse Nasionale Assessering (ANA) is standaard nasionale assessering vir tale en wiskunde. Die vraestelle en memorandums word aan skole voorsien deur die Nasionale Departement van Basiese Onderrig en skole beheer die skryf van die toetse sowel as die moderering daarvan. Die rede vir die skryf van interne vraestelle is dat die ANA-vraestelle geleë het en tussen die leerders versprei is. Die skool het vroegtydig ekstra vraestelle opgestel vir ingeval so iets gebeur. Die eksamen-rooster het onveranderd gebly, soos dit vir departementele vraestelle sou wees.

Nie al die toetse was interne vraestelle nie. Die graad 11's se fisiese wetenskappe vraestel was nog steeds departementeel.

Matthew Nel, 'n graad 11-leerder, sê hy sal eerder Grey se vraestelle skryf omdat hy weet dat die vrae sal kom uit die werk wat hulle in die klas behandel het en dan kan die onderwyser hulle beter help om voor te berei vir die toets. Hy dink dat die moeilikheidsgraad van die vraestelle hoër is as dié van die Grey-vraestelle.

Matthew sê: "Toegang tot die departementele vraestelle is te maklik en leerders verkry die inligting met min moeite. Kontrole oor die vraestelle moet strenger wees, veral aangesien ons departementele vraestelle aan die einde van die jaar moet skryf."

Afrika, sing julle harte uit en bring die Kampioen-beker huis toe

Die Grey-koor gaan gedurende die wintervakansie, van 4 tot 8 Julie aan die 10de *World Choir Games* deelneem. Dit sal die eerste keer wees dat die koor aan hierdie internasionale kompetisie gaan deelneem en daar word maar verwag dat die kompetisie straf sal wees.

Die *World Choir Games* is die grootste koorkompetisie ter wêreld. Dit word twee keer per jaar in geselekteerde stede regoor die wêreld aangebied.

Die mees onlangse kompetisie is in die stad Sochi in Rusland gehou. Hierdie jaar het die eer Suid-Afrika toegekom en die koorspele word in Pretoria gehou. Dit is die eerste keer dat 'n *Interkultur* geleentheid op die Afrika-vasteland sal plaasvind. Na verwagting gaan ongeveer 80 kore tydens die twee weke aan die *World Choir Games* deelneem.

Die afgelope paar maande het die ouerkomitee van die koor die byna onmoontlike reggekry deur ongeveer R80 000 se fondse in te samel vir die toer na Pretoria die vakansie; hoofsaaklik deur middel van verskillende borge.

Die koor gaan vyf liederes sing, naamlik *Mae-e (Forward)* wat 'n Japannese lied is, opgedra aan die slagoffers van die tsunami in 2011; *Potpourri* wat 'n medley van 'n klomp Afrikaanse liederes is, *Sound Off* en 'n Afrika-lied, *Obofile*.

Grey sal in die kategorie: *Young Choirs of Equal Voice*, deelneem.

Ander kore soos Affies, Oranje Meisieskool, Eunice en Hoër Jongenskool Paarl sal ook in dieselfde kategorie as Grey deelneem.

Kore wat aan hierdie kompetisie deelneem, word deur die artistieke komitee gekies en nie-professionele kore mag ook deelneem. Beoordeling geskied volgens die evaluasiestelsel van die *World Choir Games* wat 'n 100-punt stelsel is.

Die goue medalje-koor met die meeste punte in elke kategorie sal as kampioen van die *World Choir Games* aangewys word.

Die koor is reeds hard aan die oefen en tot dusver lyk dit asof die koorspele 'n baie verrykende ervaring sal wees.

Springboks signing session draws huge crowd of boys

On Wednesday 13 June, the Springboks visited Grey College for a signing session.

The session was in anticipation of the international friendly against England in Bloemfontein. According to News24, this will be the third test between South Africa and England in Bloemfontein. In June 2000, England, under the captaincy of Martin Johnson, undertook a five-match tour to South Africa. Two test matches were played of which the first was won by the Springboks in Pretoria.

The second international, which was the first test for England at the Free State Stadium (as it was called back then) in Bloemfontein, was won 27-22 by England.

Learners and rugby fans from all over Bloemfontein were primed to greet their team with

a warm welcome. The primary school learners, all dressed in their Springbok memorabilia, were excited to meet the Springbok players.

The players themselves were quite overwhelmed by how many people showed up, as they didn't expect so many fans to attend the signing session. But this was not viewed as a negative thing as they were motivated to see who they were playing for and how many people would support their game on Saturday 16 June. It is fully expected that the City of Roses will be green and gold on Saturday.

The session started at 11:00 and ended at 13:00. Although most of the players present were not Old Boys, it was an opportunity for those who had never yet visited Grey to finally visit the school that

produced 45 Springbok players, 17 Springbok Sevens players and 97 SA Schools U/18 players.

The visit by the players came at a seemingly unfortunate time due to the ongoing exams; however, those who took time off their study schedule to get a rugby ball signed had no regrets in the short-term. The opportunity to meet the Springboks came as a well-deserved break and reward for the long hours spent on studying and writing draining exams.

The visit was an inspiration for all the aspiring rugby players at school to keep doing what they could to be with on panel one day, signing shirts -and sometimes faces- of the future generations of the school that aided in putting them on the map.

I can remember fondly at my first Reunie dinner, which was the 10 year reunion of our 1985 class. We commonly used the Grey Shake at school, but to see your classmates after 10 years, all gone in different directions, represented in all walks of life, this Grey Shake cuts you right back to your size!

I remember so well on this October night as a youngster, there were Springbok rugby players, well known business people, politicians, attorneys, teachers etc. etc. However, as you reach out to greet your classmate, you are nothing but an old Grey boy, and everybody present there that night share exactly the same memories from school, which is the root and foundation of lifelong friendships. This Grey Shake is one ingredient of the glue that keeps us Grey boys together, and believe me, it sticks!

Hierdie Grey Shake is vir die eksklusiewe gebruik van Grey seuns, onderwysers en oud-Greys. Dit is nie om snaaks te wees nie, ons het net iets in gemeen wat 'n mens regtig vir niemand kan beskryf wat nie self hier op skool was nie. Ons besef dis nie 'n reg nie, maar 'n henge voorreg!

Boys should also know that the Grey Shake goes far beyond any kind of fist pump, high five or whatever way of greeting may be used in different cultures or pier groups. The Grey Shake unites cultures, more than anything else.

Grey neem jaarliks aan ongeveer ses amptelike interskole geleenthede deel, waarvan minstens drie nie op eie bodem plaasvind nie. Vir die “weg-inters”, maak die skool gebruik van soveel as 18 toerbusse om die Grey-seuns veilig tot by die gasheerskool te vervoer en weer terug te bring.

Hoewel treintoere goedkoper as busritte was, is dit ongelukkig nie vandag meer moontlik nie. Suid-Afrika se spoorweg-infrastruktuur is te bevraagteken wat die seuns se veiligheid in gedrang mag bring en SpoorNet is nie in staat om treine eenkant toe te skuif vir interskole geleenthede nie. Dus moes Grey noodgedwonge die skuif na busse as vervoermiddel maak.

“Busritte is ongelukkig net te onpersoonlik met die beknoptheid wat almal tot hulself isoleer,” sê Mnr Ingo Machts.

Tot en met 2010 het leerders, afrigters en personeel per trein na die “weg-inters” gery. Passasiers het op die betrokke Vrydagmiddag die trein geklim en is dan in kompartemente, wat tot ses persone huisves, opgedeel. Daar is gewoonlik die Vrydagaand op die trein geslaap en die Saterdagoggend het die spanne by hul bestemming arriveer. Leerders het hul onderskeie wedstryde dieselfde Saterdag gespeel en dan weer op die trein terug na Bloemfontein vertrek. Huisvesting was dus nog nie 'n term wat met elke interskole gepaard gegaan het nie, behalwe wanneer Grey na Paul Roos Gimnasium en Hoër Jongenskool Paarl moes reis.

Gesinne is later ook genooi om deel te wees van hierdie samehorigheid, waar ouer personeel graag hul Grey-herinneringe met die leerders gedeel het.

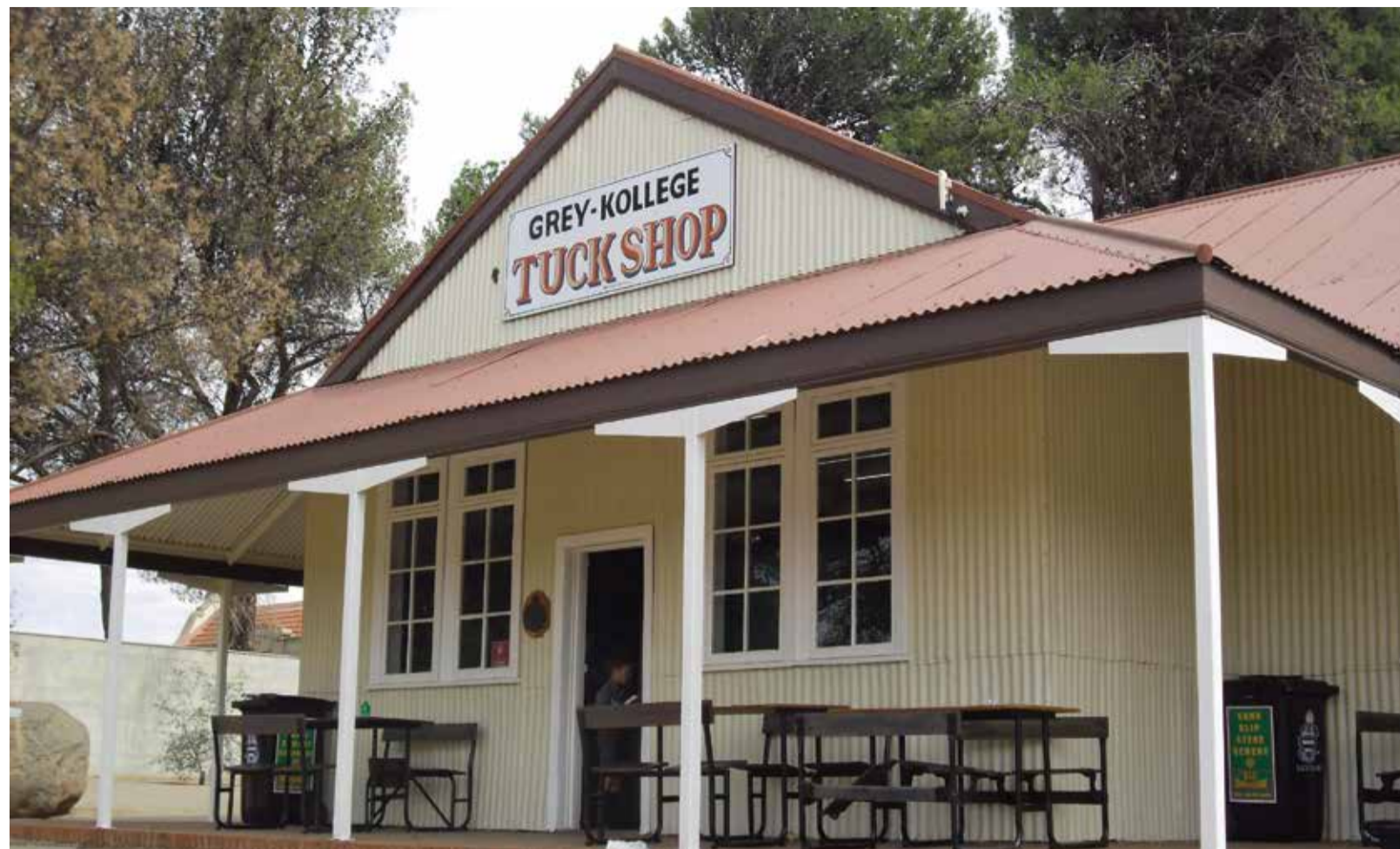
This programme has the potential to solidify the true character of the school so that, hopefully, future generations will still be able to showcase the values the school was originally built on.

Die legendariese *Tuck Shop* is beslis die bymekaarkom- en kuierplek vir talle Grey-seuns, oud-Greys en somer die res van die Grey-familie. Vir etlike jare word vriendskappe hier gebou en stories gedeel. Word die tradisionele spyskaart gemis? Bring die gebou met sy hedendaagse afwerking nog heimwee terug? Of is dit nou net 'n snoepwinkel soos by ander skole?

Die huidige *Tuck Shop*, langs die welbekende Fischer-tuin, is op 11 Mei 1984 amptelik geopen en ingehuldig, na afloop

van die verskuiwing vanaf die oorspronklike staanplek, vandag bekend as Eunice-gronde. Die ikoniese geboutjie het gedurende die loop van 2017 talle opgraderings ondergaan, gegrond daarop om die veiligheid van die gebou op te skerp. Terwyl talle beweer dat die gebou sy persoonlikheid met die opgradering verloor het, is die moderne voorkoms tog vir mense aantreklik.

Tydens 'n meningsopname onder leerders is bevind dat 91% van leerders die "ou *Tuck Shop*" verkies.

Leerders spreek hulle menings uit gegrond op hoër pryse en 'n gebrek aan tradisie en daar blyk 'n verlange onder die leerders na die vorige spyskaart te wees. Is dit slegs die heimwee en vrees vir verandering wat hierdie leerders takel? Daar is nou slegs een snoepwinkel en nie meer 'n keuse tussen *Grey Together* en die *Tuck Shop* nie. Dit kon gelei het tot die hoër pryse weens die monopolie. Grey-seuns is sterk gekant teen die opgraderings. 82% van leerders wat aan die opname deelgeneem het, voel dat die *Tuck Shop* nie meer die karakter van voorheen uitbeeld nie.

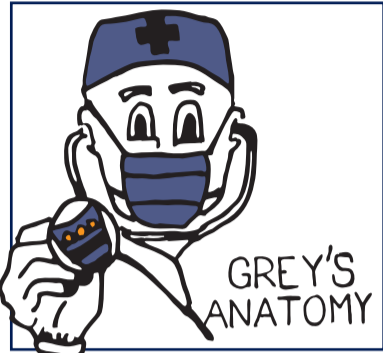

The 'wand' of success is in the hands of every Grey learner

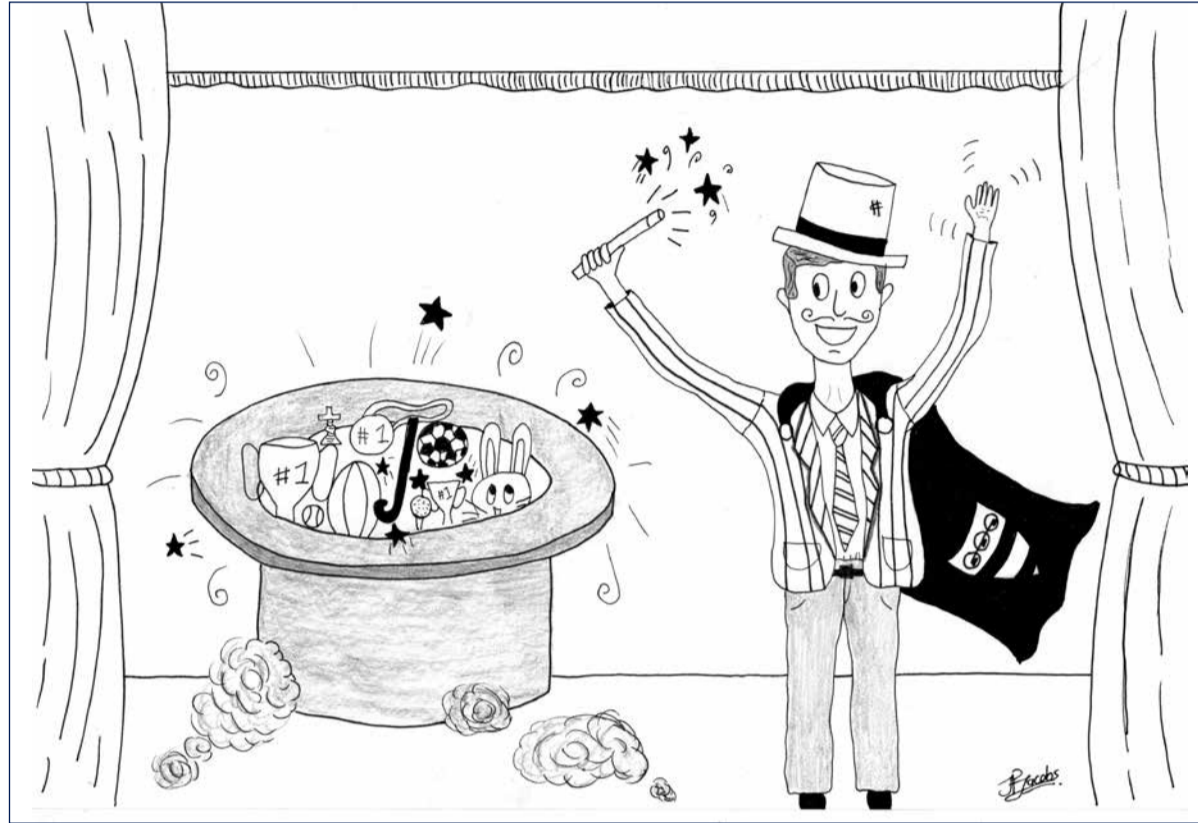


The essence of Grey Magic is the desire to succeed. Day after day, week after week, year after year a Grey boy gives his heart, sweat and tears to this school.

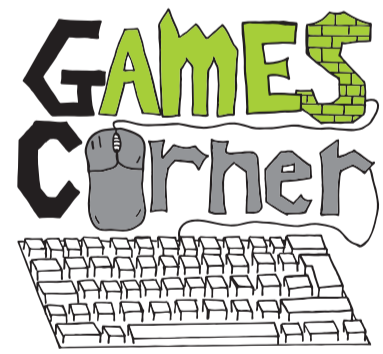

Cory Barlog's *God of War 4* was initially released on the 20th of April 2018. It is the sixth-best-selling PlayStation 4 game with over 3,1 million copies sold.

The game was designed by Derek Daniels and written by Matt Sophos, Richard Zangrande Gaubert and Cory Barlog. *God of War 4* is for single player only and available on PS4. The game is the third-highest-rated PS4 game with ratings of 94% by *Metacritic* and *GameFAQs-GameSpot*.

The protagonists of the game are Kratis and his young son Atreus. The antagonist is the Norse



god Baldur. The game is based on Norse mythology. The tremendous change is that Kratos does not use his double chained blades, the Blades of Chaos but a magical axe called the Leviathan Axe. The axe is infused with ice elemental magic.

The game takes place in Midgard. The beginning of the game starts with the passing of Kratos's second wife, Faye, who is also Atreus's mother. Her last wish is for her ashes to be spread at the highest peak of the nine realms. Kratos and Atreus travel on a journey to the highest peak of the nine realms to honour Faye's wish.

They face risks along their journey, each more dangerous than the last.

The graphics of this game have much improved over the last couple of years and the story line is relatable in a sense that people want to honour loved ones and show their appreciation.

I think that this is a great game to play as it teaches one to always care about the people you love and always know what you are fighting for. Therefore, I give this game a rating of 8,5/10.

It is the perfect excuse to stay inside and take some shelter against the winds of winter.

'n Baie suksesvolle toer na die Paarl is afgesluit deur die eerste rugbyspan, wat hul opponente tweede viool laat speel het. Grey het die kwaai vuurdoop deurstaan en met 'n telling van 34-20 koning gekraai.

Grey Kollege (1855) en Paarl Boys High (1868) is van die oudste skole in Suid-Afrika, bekend vir hul ryke geskiedenis, tradisie, en dat albei histories ook uiters uitmuntende rugbyskole is.

Die eerste wedstryd tussen die

twee skole het in 1950 plaasgevind. Sedert 1950 het Grey en Boys' High 44 keer kragte gemeet, waarvan Grey 33 oorwinnings behaal het, Paarl Boys 9, en daar was ook twee gelykop-uitslae.

Die HoërJongenskool Paarl is vanjaar 150 jaar gelede gestig. Daar was aan die begin van die seisoen groot verwagtinge vir hul jaar se rugby, en hul span is dan ook die "Dream Team" gedoop.

Hul span was ook dan voor hierdie interskole onoorwonne vir

'n fenomenale opeenvolgende 59 wedstryde, of ongeveer 3 jaar (teen Suid-Afrikaanse spanne). Voor dié toer het mnr. Jannie Geldenhuys in 'n vinnige klasbespreking gesê: "Die 150-jaar trui is 'n swaar trui om oor jou kop te trek omdat die verwagtinge vir jou jaar so hoog is." Hy verwys na 2005, toe Grey 150 geword het, en ook verskeie nederlae ervaar is.

Na hierdie wedstryd het selfs die voormalige Springbok, Naas Botha, op SuperSport die volgende

kommentaar gelewer: "Jy weet, haal jou hoed af vir Grey, want ek dink iemand kry iets verskriklik reg. Dis maklik om te sê dat hulle veronderstel is om te wen, want hulle is Grey, maar om dit jaar na jaar te doen, verg iets wat ek dink almal betrokke by skolerugby, regoor die land nastreef."

Dit was nie net die eerstespan wat goed presteer het nie. Uit 62 verskillende aktiwiteite wen Grey 41 en verloor 18.
